

Insights inside the foaling mare

The Department of Reproduction, Obstetrics and Herd Health, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Gent University, Belgium has released a DVD which illustrates Equine Obstetrics. The DVD provides a 60 minutes film, 3D Animation on scientifically correct presentation of normal development of the foal, normal and abnormal stages of parturition, visceral prolapse, uterine torsion, inversion of the bladder, retained fetal membranes, many other pre and post partum complications, 15 different types of malposture, repositions, caesarean section and much more in the mares.



The project is the outcome of dedicated work of Jan Govaree, Katrien Martens, Aart de Kruif and a team of Equine specialist from Utrecht University (Netherlands), The Ohio State University (US) and Agroalimentaire et de l'Alimentation Nantes-Atlantique (France). The DVD comes with voice-overs in English, Spanish, French, Italian, German and Text in Nederlands and Japanese.
